SIX PEOPLE KILLED IN NEPAL ACCIDENT

AT LEAST SIX people were killed and 13 were injured in a road accident in Nepal's Kalikot district on Sunday, police said. The casualties occurred when a Bolero jeep heading towards Thirpu from the Khin area in Palata Rural Municipality collided with another vehicle around 2:30 pm near Radukapre stream, a police official said. The official said the injured as well as the dead bodies were airlifted to the provincial hospital in Surkhet with the help of the security personnel.

SRI LANKA'S BRICS PLEA NOT REJECTED

SRI LANKA'S BID to join BRICS has not ended and its application to join the grouping is still pending, the Foreign Ministry here said on Sunday. It said that Sri Lanka had applied for membership and the foreign minister Vijitha Herath had written to his counterparts expressing Sri Lanka's interest to join BRICS.

UKRAINE ATTACKS MOSCOW WITH 34 DRONES

UKRAINE ATTACKED MOSCOW on Sunday with at least 34 drones, the biggest drone strike on the Russian capital since the start of the war in 2022, forcing flights to be diverted from three of the city's major airports and injuring at least five people.

Dozens killed in Israeli strikes in Lebanon, Gaza

ISRAELI STRIKES KILLED dozens of people including children on Sunday in Lebanon and northern Gaza, where the military has waged a major offensive for more than a month that aid groups say has worsened the humanitarian crisis in the besieged enclave. The Israeli airstrike in Lebanon killed at least 23 people including seven children in Aalmat village north of Beirut, far from the areas in the east and south where Hezbollah militants have a major presence. Lebanon's health ministry said another six people were wounded.

There was no immediate Israeli comment. Hezbollah began firing rockets, drones and missiles into Israel after war broke out in Gaza, in solidarity with the Palestinians and fellow Iran-backed militant group Hamas. Israel retaliated, and a series of escalations have led to all-out war. In northern Gaza, an Israeli strike on a home sheltering displaced people in the urban refugee camp of Jabaliya killed at least 17 people including

Bitcoin hits \$80,000 for the first time

BITCOIN RALLIED PAST \$80,000 for the first time, boosted by President-elect Donald Trump's embrace of digital assets and the prospect of a Congress featuring pro-crypto lawmakers. The cryptocurrency climbed as much as 4.7% to an unprecedented \$80,092 on Sunday. Trump vowed on the campaign trail to put the US at the center of the digital-asset industry, including creating a strategic Bitcoin stockpile and appointing regulators enamored with digital assets. He emerged from Tuesday's election in a stronger position than expected — his Republican

How Trump presidency can lead to a purge at Pentagon

DURING HIS CAMPAIGN for re-election, Donald Trump vowed to purge the military of so-called "woke" generals. Now that he is president-elect, the question in the halls of the Pentagon is whether he would go much further. Trump is expected to have a far darker view of his military leaders in his second term, after facing Pentagon resistance over everything from his skepticism toward NATO to his readiness to deploy troops to quell protests on US streets. Trump's former US generals and defence secretaries are among his fiercest critics, some branding him a fascist and declaring him unfit for office. Angered, Trump has suggested that his former chairman of the joint chiefs of staff, Mark Milley, could be executed for treason.

Current and former US officials say Trump will prioritise loyalty in his second term and root out military officers and career civil servants he perceives to be disloyal. "He will destroy the Department of Defence, frankly. He will go in and he will dismiss generals who stand up for the Constitution," said Jack Reed, the Democrat who leads the Senate Armed Services Committee. Culture war issues could be one trigger for firings. Trump was asked by Fox News in June whether he would fire generals described as "woke," a term for those focused on racial and social justice but which is used by conservatives to disparage progressive policies. "I would fire them. You can't have (a) woke military," Trump said. Some current and former officials fear Trump's team could target the current chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff,

With Arizona, Trump wins all swing states

DONALD TRUMP WON Arizona, the final state to be called in the US presidential election, marking a clean sweep of all seven battleground states. The Associated Press said it called the state for Trump on Saturday night as his current lead of about 185,000 votes there has put it out of reach for Vice President Kamala Harris. Joe Biden had flipped Arizona in 2020. Retaking Arizona and its 11 electoral votes brings Trump's total to 312, compared with 226 for Harris.

'Haley, Pompeo will not join administration'

PRESIDENT-ELECT DONALD Trump said he won't invite his former ambassador to the United Nations, Nikki Haley, or former Secretary of State Mike Pompeo to join his new administration. "I very much enjoyed and appreciated working with them previously, and would like to thank them for their service to our country," he said. Republicans are on track to win total control of government, having gained the White House and the Senate while leading in the race for the House of Representatives.

The four-star general, who is Black, issued a video message about discrimination in the ranks in the days after the May

2020 murder of George Floyd by a police officer in Minneapolis, and has been a voice in favour of diversity in the US military. Asked for comment, Brown's spokesperson, Navy Captain Jereal Dorsey, said, "The chairman along with all of the service members in our armed forces remain focused on the security and defence of our nation and will continue to do so, ensuring a smooth transition to the new administration of President-elect Trump." Trump's vice president-elect, JD Vance, voted as a senator last year against confirming Brown to become the top US military officer, and has been a critic of perceived resistance to Trump's orders within the Pentagon. "If the people in your own government aren't obeying you, you have got to get rid of them and replace them with people who are responsive to what the president's trying to do," Vance said in an interview with Tucker Carlson before the election.

Bangladesh to seek Interpol help to repatriate Hasina

BANGLADESH'S INTERIM GOVERNMENT on Sunday said it will seek Interpol's assistance in repatriating deposed prime minister Sheikh Hasina from India, and other "fugitives", to face trial for alleged crimes against humanity. Hasina and her party leaders face accusations of ordering brutal suppression of the Anti-Discrimination Students Movement, resulting in



numerous casualties during the July-August protests. The movement later intensified into a large-scale uprising, forcing Hasina to secretly flee to India on August 5.

Over 60 complaints of crimes against humanity and genocide have been filed against Hasina and her party leaders with the ICT and the prosecution team till mid-October. "A Red Notice will be issued through Interpol very soon. No matter where in the world these fugitive fascists are hiding, they will be brought back and held accountable in court," Law Affairs adviser Asif Nazrul said after inspecting the status of renovation at the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT).
